# **Cycling Security Updates**

#### 529 Garage



Christchurch City Council is partnering with Canterbury Police to launch 529 Garage bike registration database locally. When this was launched in Vancouver there was a 40% reduction in bike thefts over 4 years, and an increase in bikes being recovered and returned to their owners
